Art in the Burbs is returning to Tigard High School for 2017. Tigard High is conveniently located between I-5 and Hwy 99 West.

NEW FOR 2017-Art in the Burbs is changing to a 2 day show and will be held on Saturday and Sunday only. Show hours have changed slightly 10am-7pm on Saturday and 10am-5pm on Sunday. Artist set up will be Friday afternoon.

20% of each artist's sales will be retained to benefit The Foundation for Tigard-Tualatin Schools' (FTTS') *Art in the Burbs Grant* program. Grants are awarded to each of the district's schools to use only in their Arts programs - music, fine art, performing art and writing. FTTS is a 501(c)(3) organization.

ARTIST APPLICATION INFORMATION:

By MAY 15th Deadline for application submission

By JULY 1st Artists notified of their status (accepted, wait-listed or denied) via email

By AUG. 1st Booth fee due (per accepted artist)

- o Booth fee is non-refundable if artist cancels show participation AFTER September 15
- o A \$25 fee will be charged for returned (NSF) checks.

ARTIST SALES:

20% of each artist's sales will be deducted to benefit The Foundation for Tigard-Tualatin Schools (FTTS). The Foundation (FTTS) is a non-profit organization.

SHOW SET-UP INFORMATION:

Booth Sizes/Fees: Standard – 8' x 8' \$85.00

Limited Availability – 10' x 10' \$130.00

Indicate preference on application

Height limit – 9'

Preferred booth sizes are NOT GUARANTEED. Booth assignments will be made at the discretion of board members with every effort to satisfy the artists' request. Booth fee for accepted artists is due August 1st.

Electricity: We have a limited amount of booth space with electrical access. Indicate request on application.

Booth Criteria: Artists are responsible for providing all set-up materials (panels, racks, tables, display units, fixtures). Tables must be skirted to the floor. We provide one chair (per artist) for each booth. Canopy frames are permitted and must fit within the perimeter of the booth space. Canopy roofs are prohibited.

There is no storage space available adjacent to the booths or behind the booths. Oversized artwork and artwork of any kind may not be displayed beyond the dimensions of the booth.

We encourage you to bring promotional material about your artwork or yourself to enhance your display.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

Artwork must be comparable in size, style, and quality to the work in images accepted through the jury process. If you plan, for instance, to show jewelry within your glass category, please include your jewelry images for jurying purposes. Art in the Burbs will ask that any work brought to the show that falls outside your juried category be removed.

All artwork must be original and created by, or under the direction of, the artist(s).

Art must consist of predominantly handmade parts.

We do not accept any vendors selling goods that were not handcrafted by themselves. This includes importers of handcrafted goods.

ARTIST ATTENDANCE:

We strongly encourage artists to be present throughout the show or personally designate a representative. Our event sales history shows a strong correlation between artists' attendance and high sales volume throughout the weekend. Art in the Burbs is not responsible to cover artist booths in their absence.

FOOD:

Food and beverages will be available for purchase on Saturday and Sunday from on-site food vendors. An artist lounge will be available for artists that is quiet and removed from the crowds.

CENTRAL CHECK-OUT:

All purchases will be made through our central checkout area. No exceptions. This includes custom orders taken at the show. We provide show runners who are on the floor throughout the show, taking customer items back to our HOLD AREA. More details on central checkout will be provided prior to the show.
