Alberta Rider	\$1200	"Growing toward a better tomorrow" Collaborative Art Mural with one panel painted by each grade to hang in the main hallway. Art Literacy supplies for an additional art project for all grades.
Art Rutkin	\$1200	School-wide Commemorative First Year Art Projects with painted handprints for grades K-1, thumb prints to create the Ram mascot for grades 2-3, and fence art depicting the school motto "You Matter" in both English and Spanish created by the 4th-5th graders.
Bridgeport	\$1200	Art Literacy Supplies for monthly projects in the styles of Romero Britto, Ebony Frison, Grandpa Chan, Tyler Gordon, Yayoi Kusama, Mike Bennett, and Maika Ting + PepToc.
Byrom	\$1200	Sound System Replacement including speakers, PA, microphones, stands and cables.
CFT	\$1200	5th Grade Mural Project where all 5th grade students will contribute to creating a mural that will be hung in our hallways. Musical instruments and supplies to make the music program more accessible including mallet instruments like xylophones and the mallets used to play them, as well as some more types of small drums and handheld percussion that are easier for small hands.
Deer Creek	\$1200	Art Literacy Supplies including 11x14 canvases for every student, and a Cricut machine, cart and accessories.
Durham	\$1200	Oregon Ballet Performance - Durham students will get to see professional dancers perform live at school. Additionally, they will get to know the dancers and learn more about their lived experiences.
Mary Woodward	\$1200	Music Department is adding a 2-Way Passive Loudspeaker and a Powered Mixer With Dual Amp.

Metzger	\$1200	Wizard of Oz performance by 3rd graders needs a few more props and a kick drum pedal. Marimba Club comprised of 4th and 5th graders needs to build standing legs for the four large soprano marimbas to enable students to play them standing up. Art Literacy program will purchase pastels, paints, markers, sharpies, tissue paper, and crayons for all students to use on the monthly art projects.
Templeton	\$1200	Art Literacy program will purchase half of the supplies needed for a year's worth of school-wide art projects.
Tualatin 	\$1200	Music Department is purchasing Microphones and Cables, and having Commissioning, Testing, and Mounting done.

Virtual Academy	\$1200	Visual Arts Department will upgrade the painting supply kits, purchase metal storage cabinets to store art kits, and add more art supplies.
Fowler Middle	\$3200	Drama Department will purchase a high resolution video camera to film performances. Ceramics Glaze and Kiln Repair so student projects can be fired and finalized in a safe manner. Band and Choir will take a field trip to a high-level professional performance to inspire students, and it will feel like a reward for being a part of the performing arts programs.
Hazelbrook Middle	\$3200	Drama Department is adding two stage microphone systems with corresponding sound boards, plus spray paint in varying skin tones for over the ear/cheek wires.
Twality Middle	\$3200	Performing Arts is purchasing a djembe drum and a tenor saxophone as it builds back its performing arts program post-pandemic.

Community High \$5300 Printmaking - A variety of small equipment and supplies to expand and

professionalize the Printmaking class setup. Printmaking is a tactile art form that allows students to express creativity while learning a technical

process through trial and error.

Tigard High \$5300

Band and Orchestra Program will purchase replacement strings for the Cellos and for the Basses.

Digital Art Department will purchase 10 Drawing Tablets to update the lab classroom.

Ceramics Department will purchase the elements needed to repair the kilns as well as the service costs so that the student projects can be fired.

Theater Lighting will add LED movable lighting equipment and a Hazer

for the theater.

Tualatin High \$5300

Theatre Department is purchasing 3 floor mics to amplify actors' voices in drama and musicals, and to enhance the auditorium's recording capabilities.

Choir Department is purchasing a wall-mounted Whiteboard with printed staff lines as well as Sheet Music for the Choir Pops Concert.

Visual Arts is purchasing a camera and lens to complete a Photography class set, a backdrop for photography purposes and documenting student work, and Printmaking equipment to offer students a chance to learn a new medium for creating multiples of an art piece without the use of a computer.

Band/Orchestra is adding a Snare drum and rock stops to hold cellos and basses in place.
